

Botanical Birthday Gift Tags

Print at home.
Tie with care.



How it works

The PDF includes two versions of the tag sheet. Use whichever matches what you have on hand.

Option A — Avery® 22802. Print directly on Avery 22802 sheets (2 × 3.5" pre-cut tags, strings included, 8 per sheet, Letter). No cutting, no hole-punching. The cleanest path.

Option B — plain cardstock. Print on any cardstock (200 g/m² or heavier), Letter size. Cut along the dotted lines — a craft knife is cleaner than scissors but neither is wrong. Punch a hole at the top, thread baker's twine or thin ribbon.

Tie to a present. The match between tag and recipient is the gift.

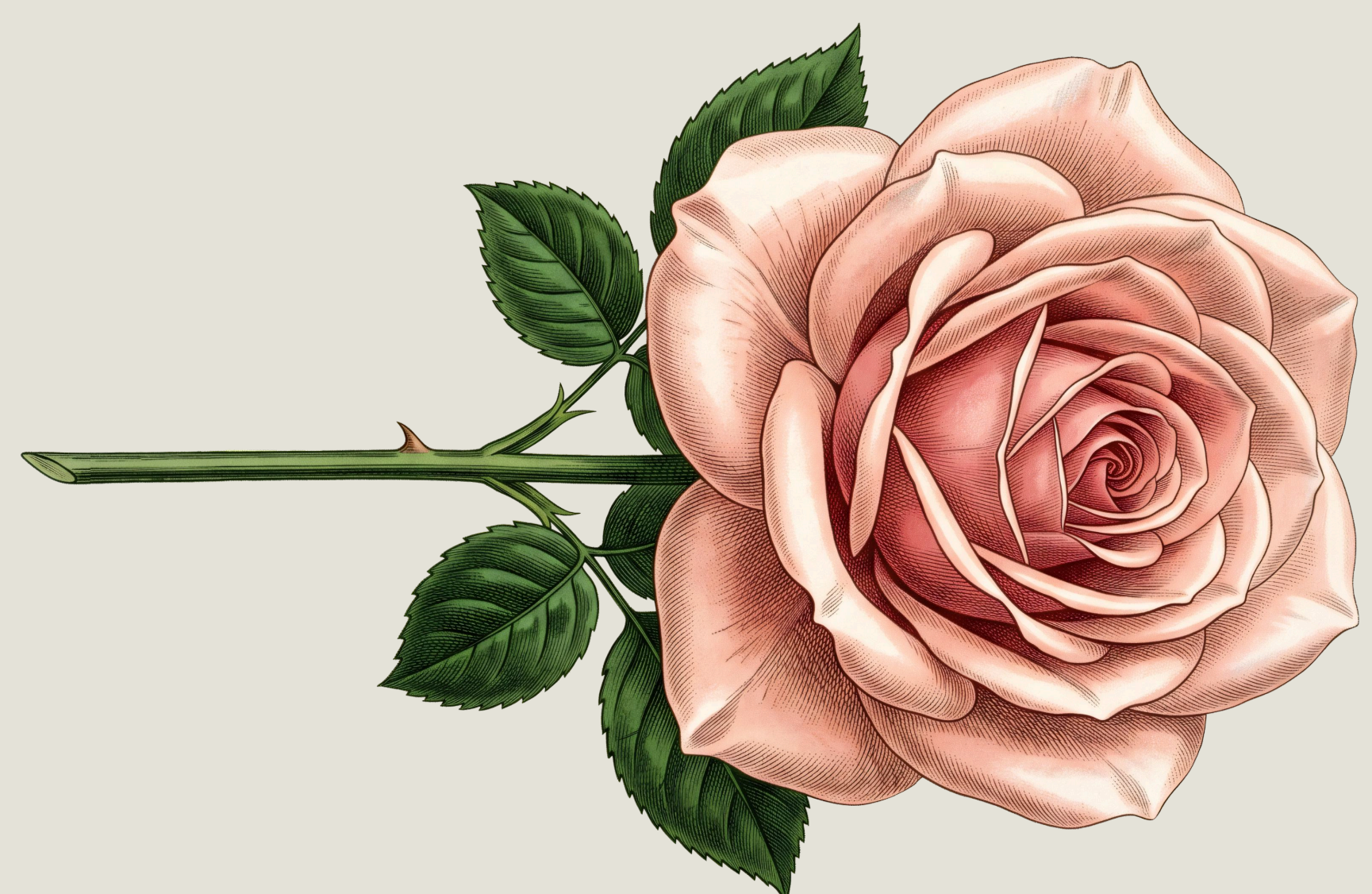

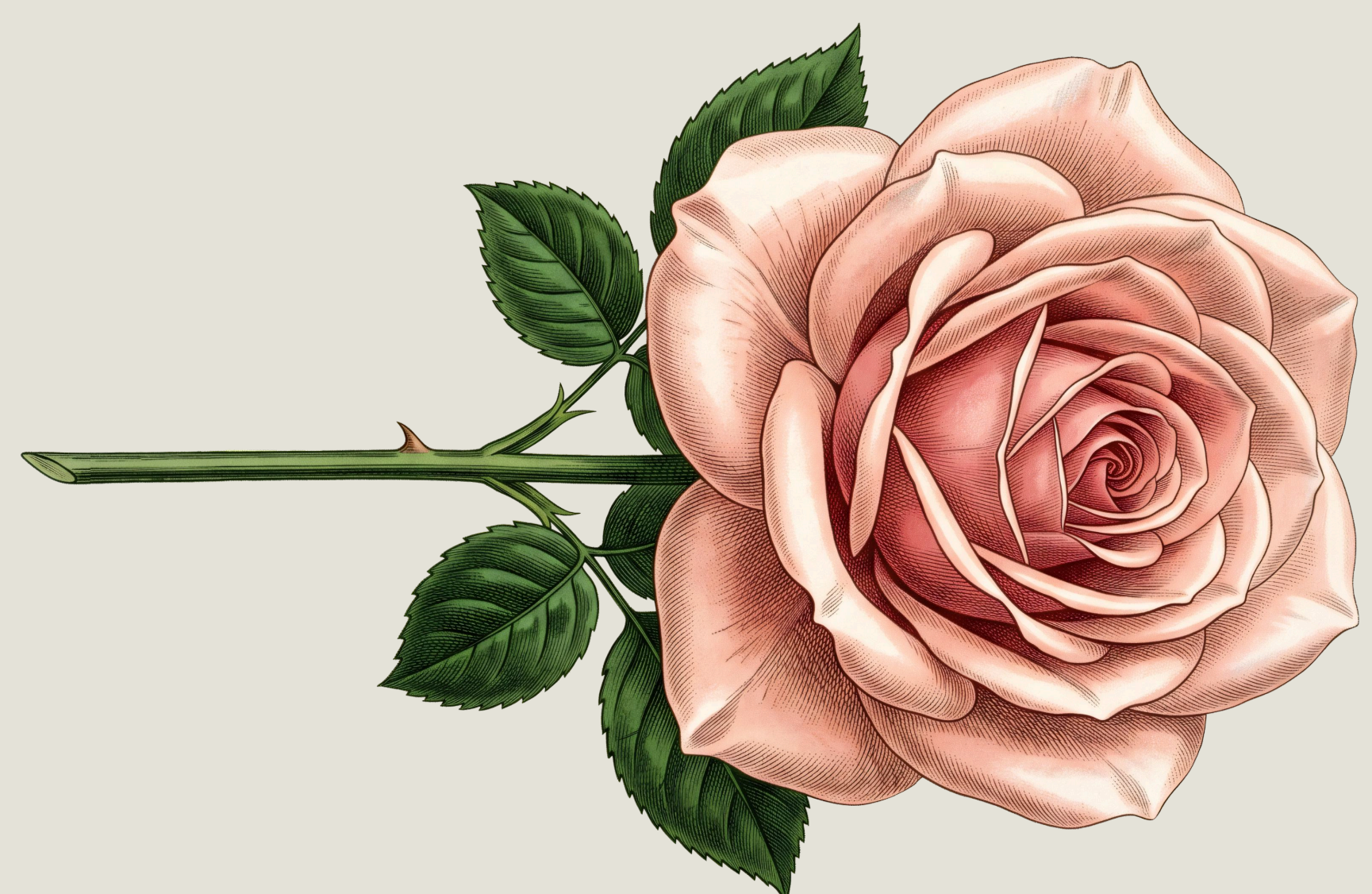

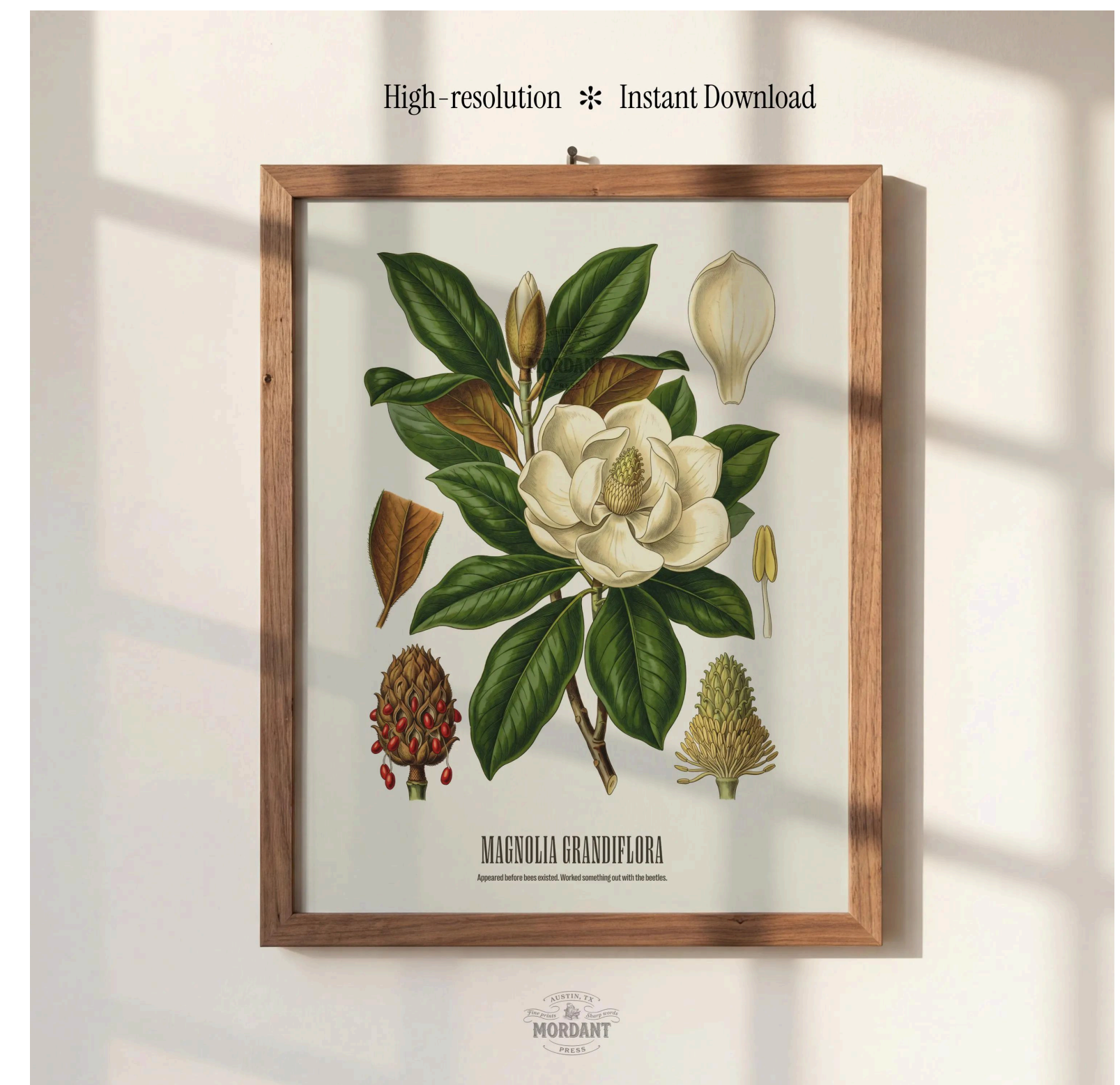

Hydrangea

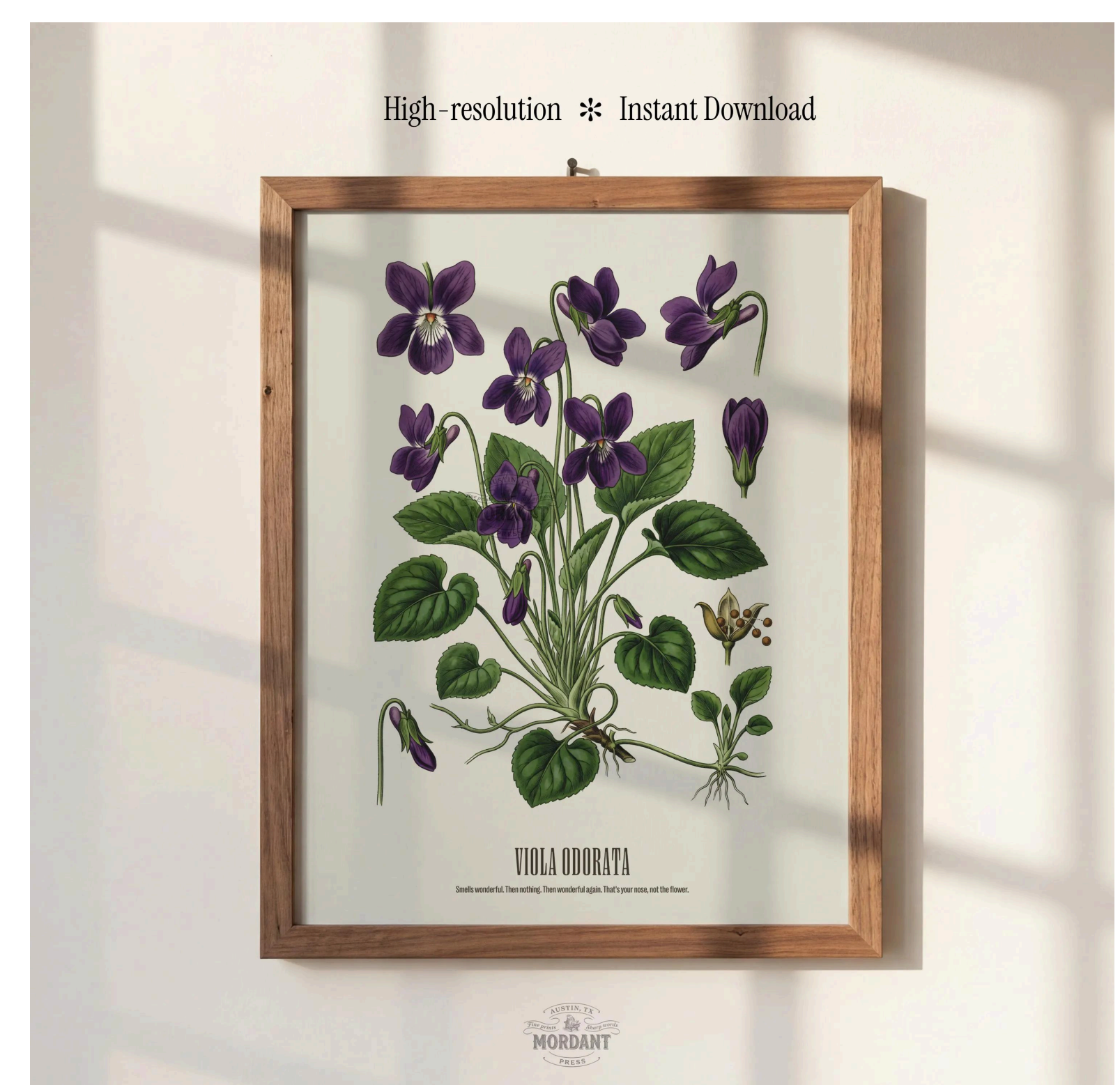
The Hydrangea macrophylla is the passive-aggressive roommate of the botanical world.

Sweet Violet

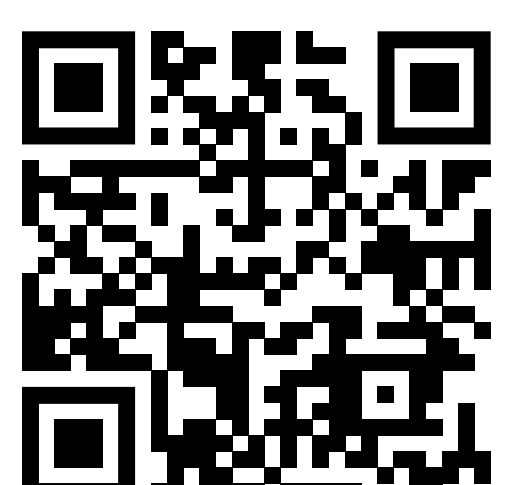
Violets contain ionone, a chemical compound that temporarily desensitizes your olfactory receptors. You take a sniff, it smells divine, and then—nothing.
